

## **School Support and Event Descriptions:**

**Classroom Volunteer** - Assist your student's classroom teacher with various classroom related tasks, such as assisting in class activities and projects, photocopying and decorating bulletin boards. Sign up during Open House at the beginning of the school year. The time commitment is up to you.

**Room Parent** – Assist your student's classroom teacher with passing along information to all the classroom parents. Perhaps organize a few special occasions in the classroom. Sign up during Open House at the beginning of the school year. The time commitment is minimal.

**Genevieve Fundraising Event** – This fall event raises money for the school by selling gift items through a catalogue. This is a big money maker for our school! Relatives and friends love it. Volunteers help organize the order forms and product dispensing when the products come in. The time commitment is 3-5 hours.

**QSP Magazine Fundraiser** - This event raises money by selling magazine subscriptions at great prices. Our school receives 40% of the subscription price. Volunteers organize the order forms. The time commitment is 3-5 hours.

**5M/5K Road Race** – This successful fundraiser is truly a community event. Over 100 volunteers come together to host a road race and fitness walk on a unique and challenging course that winds through Apple Crest Orchards. There is also a children's 1 mile race and a Fun run for children 6 & under. Professional timing services, delicious refreshments and great cash prizes make this race a favorite for seacoast runners. Volunteers and committee members are needed to keep this event running smoothly. You can man water stations, bake treats, help organize and supervise the various races and much more. The time commitment varies here. Pending on what your roles is plan on anywhere between 1 – 4 hours. This is a fun one!

**Box Tops / Supermarket Fundraisers** - This is a yearlong fundraiser. Volunteers raise awareness and help create contests to collect box tops and various other fundraising things offered by our local supermarkets. These sources have become more lucrative in the past few years. The time commitment is approximately 5 – 10 hours for the whole school year.

**Fundraising Committee** – As the times change, the PTO is continuing to look for new ways to raise money for the school. This group of individuals will come up with new ideas and help in the implementation of those ideas. The time commitment is up to you.

**Ice Cream Social** – This event kicks off the school year for our school community. We need a chairperson to help organize the set up, clean up and serving of the ice cream. The time commitment is 3-5 hours.

**PTO Bulletin Board** – Volunteers help with designing and decorating the PTO Bulletin Board located across from the main office. It is also a great resource for announcing events to be held by the PTO. The time commitment is approximately 5 – 10 hours for the whole school year.

**Halloween Party** – Volunteers transform the school gym into a haunted haven of family fun and scary delights. Decorating, set up and the supervision of game booths are the tasks at hand. This is an event open to all of Hampton Falls residents. The time commitment varies according to the role you take on.

**Book Fair** – This is a wonderful week-long event which provides an opportunity to support our school and promote reading through purchasing quality books at reasonable prices. Volunteers sign up for 1 – 2 hours intervals during the week to help children choose and purchase their books.

**LAS Unplugged** – Volunteers gather to create ways to raise awareness of the effects of media on school age children. The activities are integrated into areas in the school curriculum where it makes sense. The time commitment is 3-5 hours.

**Father Daughter Dance** – Volunteers are needed to help decorate the gym, set up refreshment tables, bake and cleanup. This is one of the most popular PTO sponsored events. It is a special night of dancing, contests, snacks and loads of fun for daughters and their dads. The time commitment is between 2 - 6 hours depending on the role you chose to take.

**Staff Appreciation** – This event is a week-long celebration including a luncheon for the entire LAS staff. Volunteers will help organize the homemade meals and treats, set up for the luncheon, serve and clean up. This is a wonderful chance to thank the teachers and make them feel as special as they are. Each year it seems that creativity takes over with how to make it a unique experience. The time commitment is 1 – 4 hours.

**Grandparents Luncheon** – Grandparent's or a special "senior" friend are invited to join the children for a very special meal and celebration. Guests are treated to choir music and a delicious feast. Volunteers set up and decorate tables, serve food and take pictures. The time commitment is 1 – 4 hours.

**Mother / Son Golf** – Volunteers help with organizing his special after school outing of golf and snacks for boy and their Mom's. This event is loads of fun and like the father / daughter dance is one of the most popular PTO sponsored events.

The time commitment is between 1- 4 hours. Dads are encouraged to help with this as Mothers are usually busy having fun with their sons.

**Field Day BBQ** – Volunteers help with an end of the year celebration for the students which includes a BBQ and outdoor field events. We need loads of volunteers for this to help serve food and assist with field events. This is a fun one for Fathers. The time commitment is 1 – 4 hours.
