

STUDENTS HOME EDUCATION

Pursuant to RSA 193-A, RSA 193:1, RSA 21-N and Administrative Rules Ed 315, parents wishing to home educate their children will submit all required documents to the Superintendent of Schools, or designee (if parent select the Superintendent as the participating agency). The Superintendent, or designee, will acknowledge in writing when all required documents are filed. A required annual evaluation of each home educated student will be received by the Superintendent, or designee, by July 1.

Home Education Students and students in non-public schools may have access to in-school courses or programs in their respective school districts when recommended by the Principal and Superintendent of Schools.

Home schooled students are eligible to participate in co-curricular activities at the discretion of the Principal. Home Education Students are not eligible for a North Hampton School diploma.
