

**CONTROL AND PREVENTION OF COMMUNICABLE DISEASES**

1. All children shall be immunized prior to school entrance according to the current Administrative Rules H3-P 301 of the State public health agency. (See attached for immunizations and documentation.)
2. Any child may be exempted from the above immunization requirements if he/she presents evidence from his/her physician that immunization will be detrimental to his/her health. A child may be excused from immunization for religious reasons at the discretion of the School Board.
3. Pursuant to RSA 200:32, "There shall be a complete physical examination by a licensed physician, physician assistant, or advanced registered nurse practitioner of each child prior to or upon first entry into the public school system and thereafter as often as deemed necessary by the local school authority.

Principals will notify parents of this requirement at the earliest possible date, so that necessary plans can be made with the family health care provider or other medical resource to accomplish this standard prior to a child being admitted to school.
