POLICY ADOPTION

When it becomes necessary to establish a policy, the Board shall direct the Superintendent or his/her designee to present a draft of such policy at its next regularly scheduled meeting for first reading. The policy shall be held for the Board and the public input for a period of one month when, with revisions, if any, it shall be an agenda item for second reading and adoption.

- 1. Publication through agenda of proposed new or revised policies.
- 2. Opportunity for concerned groups or individuals to react to policy proposals.
- 3. Recommended by the Superintendent or his/her designee.
- 4. Discussion and final action by the Board on policy proposals.

A policy shall be established at the first reading only if an emergency exists and only with 2/3 majority of the Board voting in the affirmative.

- 1. Prior to enactment, all policy proposals shall be titled and coded.
- Policies and amendments adopted by the Board shall be attached to and made a part of the minutes of the meeting at which they are adopted and shall also be included in the policy manual of the district.
- 3. Policies and amendments to policies shall be effective immediately upon adoption unless a specific effective date is provided in the adopted resolution.
