#### Personal & Social Readiness



Uses bathroom independently Dresses self (zips, buttons, snaps etc.) Knows own age and birthday Separates from parents easily Responds appropriately to adult authority Pays attention to tasks for short period of time Demonstrates self-control Completes tasks willingly Gets along well and shares with others Takes turns when playing with friends Shows an interest in learning and coming to school Follows two-step directions Knows parent's phone number and street address

#### Fine and Gross Motor



- \* Uses crayons, scissors and glue correctly
- \* Holds and writes with a pencil
- \* Traces basic shapes
- \* Cuts various lines
- \* Puts on shoes and coat without help
- Throws, catches or bounces a large ball
- 🖈 Hops, skips, jumps
- \* Climbs on playground equipment

### . Basic Cognitive Readiness-

- \* Identifies basic colors
- \* Shows an interest in books
- \* Identifies some alphabet letters
- \* Produces some letter sounds
- ★ Understands positional words (up, down, over, under, beside)
- \* Begins to write name
- \* Colors and "writes" letters and numbers
- ★ Identifies some numbers and counts objects

#### Communication Readiness.

- \* Speaks clearly and communicates needs
- \* Can say full name and birthday
- \* Uses phrases and complete sentences
- \* Knows parents' first and last names
- \* Follows directions and rules
- \* Listens without interrupting
- ★ Can take conversational turns

(Direct Instruction/small group/one-on-one conferencing/partner work)

- \* Read Aloud/Social Emotional Learning
- \* Math
- Tunified Arts: PE, Spanish, Art, STEM and Music

#### Help Your Child Prepare

- Make sure they are receiving plenty of rest (10-12 hrs/night)
- Meals should be nutritious and unhurried
- Encourage your child to be polite and to express their feelings
- Provide numerous opportunities for experiences with books
- Read to your child
- Help your child begin practicing writing their name correctly
- Play rhyming games and sing rhyming songs
- Play with puzzles
- Build with blocks
- Encourage chores for your child
- Provide imaginative play
- Provide opportunities for play with other children, as well as by themselves.



# REGISTER YOUR CHILD FOR KINDERGARTEN

- Proof of Residency
- Birth Certificate
- ImmunizationRecords
- Current Physical

#### Required Health Records

#### Current Physical Exam:

· Within one year from the start of school.



#### Immunizations:

- DTaP/Tdap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis)
- IPV (Poliomyelitis)
- HepB (Hepatitis B)
- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- VAR (Varicella/Chicken pox)

The law provides that children not in compliance with these requirements be "conditionally enrolled" if documentation is provided of at least one dose of the required immunization along with an appointment to receive the next dose, otherwise the child will be excluded from school.

#### Health Services

Please contact the school nurse if your child has a medical condition that may require nursing services, including medications, during the school day.

#### Allergies:

- Students may not share food
- No foods are prohibited, some classrooms may request parents avoid certain foods

#### Medications



All medications must go through the health office

- Includes OTC meds and supplements (advil, lactaid)
- Physician order required for prescription meds

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


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
