## Social Studies: Mr. Codair

We began our unit on Mexico this past week and we are off to a strong start. We have learned about Día de Muertos (Day of the Dead), and the 3 major ancient civilizations of Mesoamerica. We will begin honing in on the Aztec, Maya, and the Inca civilizations next week in order to have some background information for our Night at the Museum project coming up. BIG things ahead including our Mexican Fiesta party at the end of the month. More info to follow!

#### Language Arts: Mrs. Dowe

Students read, "The Most Dangerous Game" by Richard Connell and worked in groups to complete a plot map. Using their plot maps, students wrote a summary of the short story, using text evidence to support their writing.

We also worked on identifying themes. Students watched an ESPN E60 titled *Will Power*, featuring a wrestler who has cerebral palsy and perseveres to earn his first win. Students used Will's story to determine the theme, or life lesson.

Today we finished reading "The Veldt" by Ray Bradbury. Students worked in groups to determine the theme using the evidence gathered from the story.

Next week we will work on our Night at the Museum project creating artifacts from different ancient civilizations to put on display!

## Math: Mr. Felch

Next week, students will begin a new unit on rational numbers. We will begin by exploring negative numbers this week.
